HER FEMININITY

Royal Albatross is a Tall Ship. That means she is a traditional old-fashioned ship with tall masts. By the way, all ships are referred to as "she". Extending 10m out in front of the ship, the bow sprit provides an anchor point for the forestays and allows the foremast to be stepped further forward.




LEARNING THE ROPES

All 200+ ropes have a special place on their "pin rail" which is where they are secured using a belaying pin. The belaying pin can be pulled out if it's necessary to quickly depower the sails. The phrase "learning the ropes" comes from tall ships where the crew had to learn the position and purpose of every rope.



CRAFTED WITH LOVE

With around 150 tall ships left worldwide and only a handful in passenger service, the Royal Albatross is a rare manually operated sailing ship requiring traditional and specialist skills to operate and maintain her. She was handcrafted by her loving crew and owner during a 6-year refurbishment.



TO GREATER HEIGHTS

The Monkey Island is located on top of the bar roof and is a fully equipped sound stage where bands and performers entertain regularly. Monkey Island is the name given to the highest accessible point on a ship where sailors would go to perform solar and stellar observations.



HER CLASSIFICATION

The Royal Albatross is a RINA classified "Class A" tall ship, meaning she is a square rigged sailing ship over 40m in length. Specifically she is a Barquentine, meaning her square sails are located on the foremast. Under the surface, she is equipped with the latest navigation and safety technologies.



FEATURED IN HOLLYWOOD

The ship's interior is made from Kempas - a local hardwood over 100 years old. All the carpentry onboard was handcrafted by the ship's crew. Royal Albatross' claim to fame was being featured as Bruce Wayne's private yacht in the second Batman movie "The Dark Knight" starring Christian Bale and the late Heath Ledger.



GOLDEN AGE OF SAIL

Tall Ships were the form of transport in the mid-19th century, equivalent of today's container ships, passenger cruise ships and warships. The Royal Albatross is not equipped for trade or warfare, but it provides the chance for visitors to experience what it must have been like to sail a tall ship in a bygone era!
