

****Royal Albatross Passenger Identity Verification Policy****
****Passenger Identity Verification Requirement****

For the safety, security, and welfare of all passengers, crew, and guests onboard the Royal Albatross, all passengers are required to present a valid government-issued photo identification document prior to boarding. Acceptable forms of identification include:

- Passport
- National Identity Card
- Driver's Licence
- Other government-issued photo identification deemed acceptable by Royal Albatross management

Why We Require Identification

The identity verification process serves several important purposes:

1. Passenger Safety

In the unlikely event of an emergency, including search and rescue operations, medical emergencies, evacuation procedures, or other incidents at sea, it is essential that we can accurately identify every passenger that boarded the vessel.

2. Security Requirements

As a commercial passenger vessel, Royal Albatross has a responsibility to maintain a safe and secure environment for all guests, crew members and partners. Verifying passenger identities helps us mitigate security risks, support emergency response procedures, and fulfil these obligations.

3. Operational Accountability

Accurate passenger records are necessary to ensure proper manifest management and compliance with maritime operational requirements.

Conditions of Boarding

Presentation of valid government-issued photo identification is a condition of carriage and boarding on the Royal Albatross.

Passengers who are unable or unwilling to verify their identity using an acceptable government-issued photo ID will not be permitted to board the vessel.

Right to Refuse Boarding

Royal Albatross reserves the right to refuse boarding to any individual who cannot satisfactorily verify their identity prior to departure. This requirement applies equally to all passengers and is implemented solely for safety, security, and operational reasons.
